What to Expect:

What to Bring:

- Sleeping bag and pillow
- Twin-sized air mattress and pump
- Toiletries: shampoo, deodorant, toothbrush/paste, shower shoes, bath towel
- Bible, notebook, pen
- Spending money: 4 fast food meals and snacks while traveling, 1 nice dinner out
- Sunscreen, hat, beach towel, swimsuit (see "what to wear")
- Camera
- Medications if needed
- Comfortable/old sneakers for service projects
- No alcohol, drugs, firearms, weapons, etc.

Food:

We will be cooking and/or eating most of our meals at the church. Breakfast will be together at the church buffet style. We will eat a sandwich for lunch each day. Dinner will be various camp favorites including lasagna, pizza, BBQ, burgers, etc. We will also have some sort of late night snack after worship. All of this is included in your registration price. Please let us know immediately if there are any medical special needs for food, and we can communicate with you what to send with your student.

You will need to bring spending money for 4 fast food meals while traveling Sunday and Saturday, 1 dinner out on Tuesday night, and any snacks you may want to purchase while on the road.

What to Wear:

You never know where you will be serving during the day or when you will have the opportunity to share the gospel, so we want to be a light in the community for Jesus, above reproach even by how we dress. All clothing must meet school dress code and be appropriate, or you WILL be asked to change. You are also expected to abide by the following:

SHORTS: Must be no more than six inches above the knee. If in doubt, follow the "finger-tip" rule.

TANK TOPS: Straps must be 2 fingers thick.

PAJAMAS: Not to be worn anywhere outside of your assigned, gender-specific area.

SWIMSUIT: Girls, wear one-pieces (tankini's are ok if the two pieces meet - if not, you will be asked to put a dark t-shirt over your existing suit). Guys, your swim shorts need to be appropriate as well and follow the shorts guidelines above.

DON'T BRING: leggings or spandex pants (leggings are not pants!), bikinis
