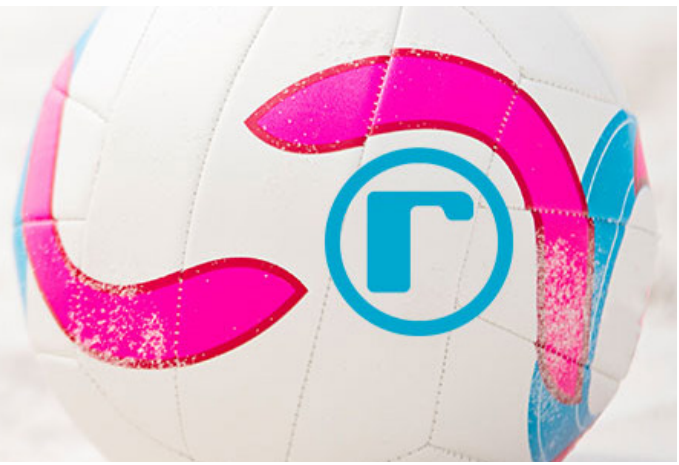


RADIATE BEACH CAMP
