The purposes of this application are 1) to give us an idea of your reasons for participating in the trip while advising us of any special needs that you might have and 2) to give you a chance to write out your motives for wanting to go on the trip. - 5. A color copy of your Passport or documentation that you have applied
- 6. Be ready to give us in the future: consent to travel form, copy of student id, copy of obtained online visa (we will walk you through this don't worry)

Please complete and return your application by **Sunday**, **March 4th**. The approximate dates of the mission trip are June 28-July 13. While on the mission field, we will do ministry/assemblies in schools, girls' ministry, after-school ministry, support of local churches, camps, etc. Programs will include a short presentation of the gospel and an invitation to follow Christ. You will also have the opportunity to participate in one-on-one witnessing (and anything else that our sponsors ask us to do). Adult chaperones will be responsible for small groups of students and you will be expected to obey them without question as they work to provide you with all the support you need on the trip. They will be working side-by-side with you as they go through the same training and fund-raising activities that you go through (requirements are listed at the end of this application). This application contains space to share the reason that you want to make this trip and a place for you and your parents to express your commitment to fund-raising and training. In addition, you will be asked to sign up for a short interview with Matt as part of the application process. We are excited that you are interested in this trip and look forward to receiving your completed application soon!

RUN FOR THE SON - 2/03/18

- Student must be registered as a runner or phantom runner.
- Student must sign up at least ten (10) adult runners or phantom runners (student registration counts as one of these).
- IN ADDITION, students must do at least ONE of the following to get credit for working the event:
 - Stuff race packets and help with setup on Friday, Feb. 5 at 7:00 PM.
 - Work on race day. You will need to sign up in the cafe.
 When you arrive on race day, go to the student volunteer table to receive your assignment. You will receive your receipt when you sign out at the table at the end of your shift. Please dress warm, because you may be assigned inside, outside, or both! (Plan to stay until 11:00 AM)
