

#### Radiate MDWK




## Manly ADDII 22

## Beach Camp - MS JUNE 13-17


That's right! Middle School is headed to the Beach for a






## Radiate Go/Give




### Radiate WRSHP Teams




#### Student Mission Trip 2022 One core principle of our vision in Radiate Students is to






